



DOCK USAGE POLICY

1. RECIPROCAL CLUBS:

Docks are reserved for the use of members' boats. If there are available docks, they may be used to moor a boat from a reciprocal club for a period of 2 days per month at no charge. If additional days are requested, up to 3 additional days will be allowed at a rate of \$1.50 / ft per day, pending availability.

2. BOATING MEMBERS:

If a boating member wishes to invite family or friends to moor a boat, if space is available, they may be allowed to stay as a guest for up to 2 days. This may occur twice per season. It is expected that the sponsoring member will be present for the duration of the visit. Guests will be asked to pay \$1.50/ft per day, unless they have a reciprocal membership.

3. YACHT CLUB MARKETING:

For purposes of marketing the Club, a boat may be allowed to moor at the club for up to 2 days. The boat owners will be considered guests of the Club and it is expected that a member of the Board of Directors will meet with the owners during their visit. No boat/skipper will be invited more than once every 3 years. These visitors will be asked to pay \$1.50/ft per day for the 2 days stay.

4. EXTENDED MOORING:

Length of Stay	Initiation & Dues	\$ Per Foot (Boat Model Length) + HST
Full Season	Required	\$68.25
2 Months	Required	\$46.00
1 Month	Not Required	\$25.00
<1 Month	Not Required	\$1.50 Per Foot / Per Day

5. ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

All boat owners/skippers MUST provide a copy of their insurance to the Dock Master or Officer of the Day upon arrival. In ALL cases, visiting boats MUST sign in with the Dock Master on arrival and keep their boat in the slip assigned by the Dock Master
