



Newport Yacht Club Stoney Creek Covid-19 Code of Conduct

Everyone who comes to the Club must adhere to the following protocols in this document and be ready and equipped to fully abide by its provisions. This is strictly for the first phase of reopening and will evolve as the COVID restrictions evolve.

As a member of the club and boat owner, you agree to the following to help ensure the health and safety of everyone associated with the club.

- **First and foremost, under any circumstances, do not come to the Club if you have any symptoms of COVID-19 or if anyone you are living with has such symptoms.** Please refer to the provincial guide for guidance <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/self-assessment/>
- When at the club, please abide by the government mandated physical distancing measures, such as maintaining 6 ft from other persons and practice proper hand washing protocol.
- Members must **SIGN IN EVERY TIME** you come to the marina at one of the 2 information boxes (one by clubhouse and one in parkette). You can also send a text: 1-905-638-4697. Please include your name, your household member names, and your dock number.
- Only members of your family living in the same household are allowed on your boat and maintain groups of no more than 5 when not on your boat.
- Large gatherings are forbidden on docks, walkways and elsewhere on the marina property and there are no visitors, guest or visiting boats allowed until further notice.
- Food and drink must only be consumed on your boat and use of the marina BBQ's is not allowed.
- All members are responsible for providing their own masks, disposable gloves and sanitizer to ensure they are comfortable with safe boating and safe socializing at the club.
