



COVID-19 PROTOCOL

AROUND THE CLUB:

- If you are sick...please stay home! Please do not come to the club if you are feeling ill or if you have been exposed to someone with Covid-19
- Social distancing must be maintained at all times around the club – maintain 2 meters or 6.5' from others at the marina
- Please move on to a finger or ramp when encountering other members as you are walking around
- **Only members living in the same household are allowed on your boat at this time**
- Gatherings are forbidden on the docks, walkways and elsewhere on the marina property
- Maintain groups of no larger than 5 when not at your boat until further notice
- Please ensure proper hand washing protocol is practiced
- Please ensure that you **SIGN IN** at one of the 2 information boxes **EVERY TIME** you come to the marina (one by clubhouse and one in parkette). You can also send a text to: 1-905-638-4697. Please include your name, your household member names, and your dock number
- Please leave at least 1 vehicle width between when parking vehicles in the lot
- Please ensure that you go straight to your boat when you arrive
- No visitors or guests until further notice
- No visiting boats from other clubs until further notice
- No reciprocals until further notice
- No cruises until further notice
- No social events until further notice
- No use of the club BBQ's until further notice.
- Boaters are to use onboard cooking facilities until further notice.

- Picnic tables and other tables/chairs will not be available until further notice
- Laundry facilities will be closed until further notice
- No use of hand carts until further notice
- We encourage all boaters to use their onboard facilities (showers and washrooms) as much as possible. Club showers will be closed until further notice.
- All food and drink are to be consumed on your boat. Eating or drinking on the marina property or anywhere on the docks is not permitted at this time.
- Pumpouts will be on a reduced schedule (schedule to be determined). Only those authorized by the Property Manager will be allowed to do pump outs. The boat owner can do the flushing of water.

Please Note: All members are responsible for providing their own face masks, hand sanitizer or gloves to ensure they are comfortable with safe boating or safe socializing at Newport.

HANDWASHING & GOOD HYGIENE PROTOCOL:

- Wash your hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer, especially after touching frequently used items or surfaces
- Avoid touching your face
- Sneeze or cough into a tissue, or the inside of your elbows
- Disinfect frequently used items and surfaces as much as possible

MOORING & SAFE BOATING PROTOCOL:

MOORING:

- Incoming vessels should radio ahead if they require assistance to dock their boat
- Do not automatically jump in to help – from a distance, ask if they need assistance before offering to grab a line
- Make use of mooring hooks where possible instead of reaching for lines (or other devices) from others
- If you do need to grab a line, ensure that you wear gloves or wash your hands immediately after

KEEPING YOUR BOAT COVID-19 FREE

- Giving your boat a spray down is good practice and the pressure of water alone could deter any germs on your deck. Lifelines, stanchions, hatch

latches, door handles, toilet flushes, and all surfaces you touch often, should be disinfected often with a good wipe-down.

- **Anytime someone has come on to your boat, sanitize your hands before coming aboard, or get on without touching anything and wash them immediately. Continue to wipe down all exposed areas on your boat.**

STAY CURRENT

- **Planning ahead also means staying up to date with closures and general news about your intended destination, port, town and region.**

SOCIAL DISTANCING WHEN BOATING

- **Only boat with those in your immediate household**
- **No beaching your boat right next to someone else**
- **Maintain your distance at the fuel dock and remember to wash your hands**
- **No rafting up – keep your distance on the water**
- **No guests on your boat! This includes family members not in your immediate household or your closest boating buddies!**
- **Go right from your house to the boat and back – no unnecessary contact with anyone!**

Enjoy your boat, the water and the fresh air, but enjoy it while boating responsibly.
