



## REVISED POLICY 2021

### PERSONAL WATERCRAFT (PWC)

#### MOTORIZED WATERCRAFT

- In this Policy a PWC is any vessel of the wet-bike or Sea Doo type.
- With effect from the season opening in 2020, regardless of membership status or size of boat or slip, no PWCs will be permitted to be docked other than at specific slips allocated by the Club in accordance with this policy. Except where indicated below, all PWCs will be charged \$500.00 + HST for the 2020 season.
- **Dinghies and yacht tenders.**
- For the purposes of this Club these craft are defined as small boats of less than 13ft in length and capable of being carried on a Member's boat. If powered they must not have a total engine power greater than 9.9hp. When in the harbour they must fit into the Member's allotted dock space together with the parent vessel. Vessels conforming to the above definition will not be subject to mooring fees. Any dinghy requiring a separate slip will be charged \$400.00 + HST and can only be moored in club allocated slips.
- Rigid Inflatable Boats (R.I.B.'s) and dinghies/tenders not conforming to the above definition will be subject to fees at the current rate for their Boat Model Length and occupy slips as separate vessels.
- The reduced rate for Grandfathered-in PWCs and dinghies will no longer be offered.
- As always, the Membership Director will continue to allocate PWC's and dinghies to a dock that best suits the needs of the Club and wherever possible place more than one PWC or dinghy at a dock. All PWC and dinghy owners must pay the appropriate fee for each PWC.

#### NON-MOTORIZED WATERCRAFT

- All other non-motorized watercraft (kayaks, canoes, paddleboats) will be located in a common area designated by the NYC-SC Board, unless they can fit together with the parent vessel.
- Any member requiring a full slip for a non-motorized watercraft (e.g. outrigger canoe) or a raft will be considered as a Patron Member and will be required to pay Mooring Fees as per other power and sailing members.

#### FUELLING OF PWCs

- **FUELLING OF PWCs MAY ONLY TAKE PLACE AT THE DESIGNATED LOCATION** (currently on "C" Dock).
- Two people must be present during fuelling.
- A fire extinguisher and dispersant are available to borrow from the Clubhouse. They **MUST** be positioned at the designated location and returned to the Clubhouse immediately after fuelling.
- An oil boom is available at the Clubhouse in the event of a large fuel spill.
- Any fuel spill must be reported immediately to The Harbour Master or VC Property.
